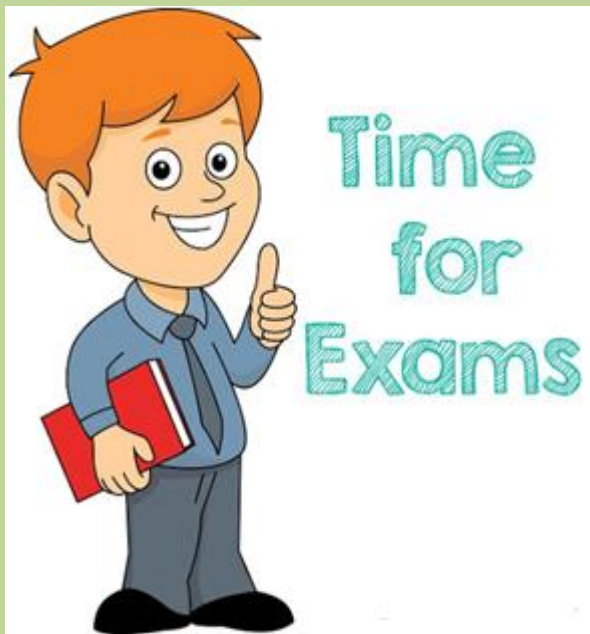
The Grapes are Sour

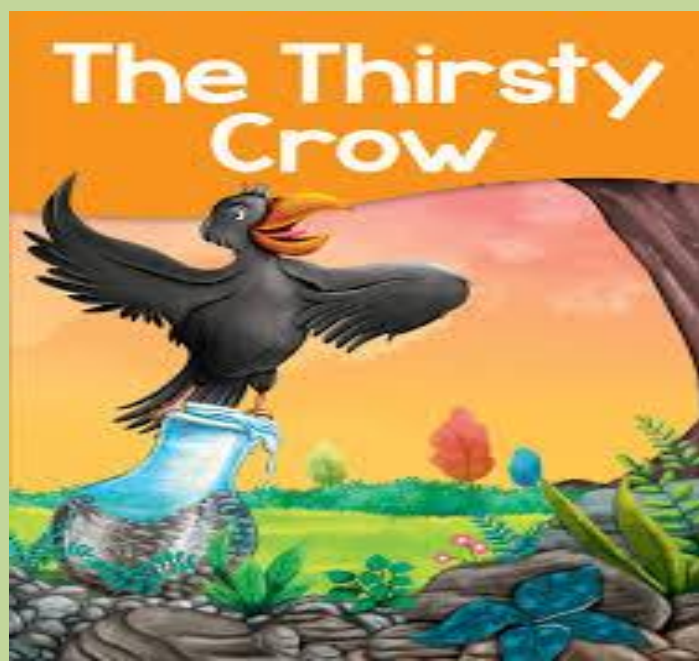
